Vocational or skill-based education is becoming more and more significant with passing time. B.Voc. (Bachelor of Vocation) is an emerging course in India that aims at providing adequate skills required for a particular trade to candidates. The course is different from traditional academic programmes as it deals more with application-based studies rather than focusing on only theoretical knowledge

B.Voc. is a three-year duration undergraduate course that can be pursued in a wide range of fields starting from Cost and Management Accountancy & Financial Market. One of the biggest advantages of pursuing B.Voc. against common degree courses is that a candidate has multiple exit points during the programme and continued industry exposure. This means that if a candidate is unable to complete his/ her B.Voc. course, s/he has is still awarded a diploma after successful completion of first year or advanced diploma after successful completion of second year. Apart from this, the work experience candidates gain during the course increases their chances of getting a job.

B.Voc. Eligibility Criteria

Candidates are eligible to apply for B.Voc course if they have successfully completed Class XII from a recognized board with minimum 50% - 60% marks.

Course Curriculum for B.Voc.

As stated above, a B.Voc. course is of three years duration divided into six semesters. The course curriculum of B.Voc. is industry-based which contains about 40% General education (theory) and 60% vocational training (practical) components.
