Objective of the Activity: The objective of this activity was to help students understand the structure of the Union Budget and to develop analytical thinking, communication skills, and awareness about government financial planning.

Description of the Activity: A classroom debate was organized on the topic “Union Budget 2026–27: Income and Expenditure Analysis.” Students were divided into two groups to understand the two major components of the Union Budget.

Group 1: Income Side of the Budget

This group focused on the sources of government income, such as taxes (income tax, GST, corporate tax), non-tax revenue, borrowings, and other government receipts. Students discussed how the government collects revenue and how these sources contribute to the national economy.

Group 2: Expenditure Side of the Budget

This group focused on government spending, including expenditure on sectors such as education, health, defence, infrastructure, agriculture, and welfare schemes. Students explained how public funds are allocated for national development and social welfare.

Students were given time to research and prepare their points using newspapers, budget summaries, and online sources. During the debate, each group presented their arguments and analysis. They discussed whether the income generated by the government is sufficient and how effectively the expenditure is planned for the country's development.

Learning Outcomes:

- Students understood the income and expenditure components of the Union Budget.
- They developed research, analytical, and presentation skills.
- The activity improved their public speaking and teamwork abilities.
- Students gained awareness about government financial management and economic policies.
